

Minutes of the Special Meeting
Bridgewater Township Hall
March 13, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 with the pledge of allegiance and all Board members except Pike. Supervisor called this special meeting in accordance with the Open Meetings Act, being posted on March 12, 2007 on both the website and at the Township Hall for the purpose to discuss and decide the township's legal status of Ace Pyro LLC.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

A citizen asked for the status of a FOIA request from Mr. Enzer for the materials presented to the Board before the meeting. Supervisor stated there was nothing distributed for this meeting. Supervisor gave him a copy of the complaint that was previously drawn up by attorney Lucas.

Clerk read from October 18, 2006 minutes stating

ACE Enterprises-PC has requested the Board to approach ACE to stop work until after all permits from the State, Federal and Local Boards have been met. Attorney Lucas advised Supervisor to move ahead with Police to close down this operation until requirements are met. Washtenaw County Sheriff is investigating. Supervisor notified the applicant of his actions.

Former Supervisor Sheth does not appear to have followed through.

MOTION: Moved by Mull, seconded by Riley to move ahead with the complaint against Ace Pyro, LLC.

Roll call vote: Carver Y, Mull Y, Faust Y, and Riley Y.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

A resident who lives next door stated that too many complaints from the neighbors are founded out of fear.

They have no concerns. Neighbors concerns are unfounded.

A resident who lives next door states he really believes our Township has more pressing issues than this. He thinks that fireworks are for the 4th of July to celebrate our founding. Other things are of much more concern. We should be more careful of who we drive out of the township. It could influence his enjoyment of living in the Township.

A comment was made asking for clear direction from the Board to the PC for the SLU Application

Response by Mull- This claim is supported by our Zoning Ordinance and Building Code. It's my duty as the legal agent for the Township to follow through on these situations.
