

Amendment to

Mineral Extraction Ordinance

An ordinance to amend Ordinance 59 of the ordinances of the Bridgewater Township, the Extraction Ordinance, by amending Section 2.03 to further define the composition of the Mineral License Board, terms and qualifications for membership.

THE TOWNSHIP OF BRIDGEWATER HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. **Amendment to Extraction Ordinance.** Subsection 2.03 of Ordinance 59 of the ordinances of Bridgewater Township, the Bridgewater Township Extraction Ordinance, is amended as follows:

2.03 **Mineral License Board.**

- A. The Mineral License Board shall be composed of five residents of the Township, with no more than two members of the planning commission being permitted to serve on the mineral licence board at appointed for two year terms by the Township Supervisor.
- B. The appointment of members 1, 3 and 5 shall end on December 31, in odd numbered calendar years, and members 2 and 4 shall end on December 31, in even number years. No more than 2 members of the Township Planning Commission may serve on the Mineral License Board.
- C. Each member of the Mineral License Board must be a resident of the Township.
- D. Any person serving on the Mineral License Board who ceases to be a resident shall be deemed to have resigned from the Board as of the date that the person ceased being a resident.
- E. A member of the Mineral License Board may be removed from office with or without cause by a majority vote of the Township Board.
- F. Any vacancy on the Mineral License Board shall be filled by appointment of the Township supervisor.
- G. Any person appointed to fill any vacancy shall serve out the term of

the person who is being replace.

- 2. **Saving Provision.** All sections of Ordinance 59, the Bridgewater Township Extraction Ordinance, not amended by this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
- 3. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.
