The property, a flagpole lot, was purchased by the WCPARC to construct a complex permitting public parking at Clinton Road and then walking access through native wetlands to a riverside meadow as well as a deck with a view of a bend in the River Raisin. The parking lot, two boardwalks, and a viewing deck have been constructed. The WCPARC is requesting after the fact the following four variances:

(1) Location of the deck 30' from the north boundary instead of the 75' specified for the front setbacks of a flagpole lot. Note that an uncovered deck on a conforming structure can extend 10' into a required setback (Section 1605) and therefore be no less than 65' from the property line in this instance.

(2) Locations of the parking lot boundaries 14' from the north line and 10' from the south line of the easement instead of the required 25' on each side. Note that in the next request the converse distances are specified, i.e., 10' on the north and 14' on the south.

(3) Reduction of the dimensions of the parking lot greenbelts from the required 20' to, respectively, 10' on the north and 14' on the south.

(4) Planting in the greenbelts of native grasses and forbs (herbaceous flowering plants) instead of commercial trees and shrubs.
