

Ordinance No. 19
Township of Bridgewater
Franchise Agreement

An ordinance to grant to the Village of Clinton the right to use the township highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places of the township to construct, maintain and use electric lines and other electric appliances and to transact a local electric business in the township for a period of thirty years.

TOWNSHIP OF BRIDGEWATER, WASHTENAW COUNTY MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Township of Bridgewater, Washtenaw County, Michigan, hereby irrevocably grants to the Village of Clinton, its successors and assigns the right to use the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places of said Township to construct, maintain and commercially use electric lines, consisting of towers, masts, poles, crossarms, guys, braces, transmission and distribution wires, transformers and Other electrical appliances on, under, along and across the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and transact a local electric business in the Township for a period of thirty years. This grant addition to and not in limitation on other rights which the may have in the Township. The use of said highways and other places shall not be unreasonably obstructe, and all work done by said Village shall be done in a good workmanlike manner. The Township "shall be kept free and harmless by said Village all loss, cost or damage which it may at any time sustain on account of the permission hereby granted.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect i immediate up on its publication, provided, however, that. it shall cease and be of no affect after thirty (30) days from its adoption unless within that period the Village accepts the. rights, cowers and authority granted to it by this Ordinance. The acceptance by the Village shall be in writing and shall be filed with the Township substantially the following form:

ACCEPTANCE

The Village of Clinton hereby accepts the franchise, consent and permit granted to it, and to its successors and assigns, to use the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places of the Township to construct, maintain and commercially use electric lines, consisting of towers, masts, poles, crossarms, guys, braces, transmission and distribution wires, transformers and other electrical appliances on, under, along and across the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and to transact a local el ectric business in the Township for a period of thirty (30) wears, as granted by Ordinance No. 19 adopted by the Township Board of Bridgewater Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, on the 18th, day of November, 1991, and, further, the Village hereby agrees to abide by the terms of that Ordinance.
