

Ordinance 40
Township of Bridgewater
Fireworks

An ordinance enacted pursuant to MCL 750.243b to regulate display of fireworks.

THE TOWNSHIP OF BRIDGEWATER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Purpose. MCL 750.243b authorizes a township board to issue a permit for the display of fire-works. However, the Township Board and the Township employees have no expertise in fireworks and are not qualified to rule on the competency and qualifications of operators or persons desiring to display fireworks or on the safety aspects of the displays. Therefore, this ordinance establishes the Township policy not to issue permits for the use or display of fireworks.

Section 2. Definition. "Fireworks" shall have the meaning described in MCL 750.243a.

Section 3. Permits. The Township Board will not issue a permit for the use or display of fireworks.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
