

BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 63

An ordinance to withdraw from the Manchester Community Joint Planning Commission.

Public Act 226 of 2003, as amended (MCL 125.131, et seq.), Bridgewater Township entered into an agreement (the Joint Planning Commission Agreement) together with Freedom Township, Manchester Township, and the Village of Manchester to form the Manchester Community Joint Planning Commission.

Pursuant to Section 8 of the Joint Planning Commission Agreement, any member wishing to withdraw from the agreement may do so but must first adopt an ordinance authorizing withdrawal.

Bridgewater Township desires to withdraw from the agreement and therefor:

BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP, WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

Section 1. WITHDRAWAL FROM MANCHESTER COMMUNITY JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION.

Pursuant to Section 8 of the Joint Commission Agreement, Bridgewater Township withdraws from the Manchester Community Joint Planning Commission.

Section 2. PAYMENT OF OBLIGATIONS.

The Township Board is authorized to pay all obligations owed by the Township to the Joint Planning Commission as required by Section 8 of the Joint Commission Agreement.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph or part of this Ordinance shall for any reason be finally adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

Section 4. REVOCATION OF AUTHORITY.

Any authority ceded to the Manchester Community Joint Planning Commission by virtue of the Joint Planning Commission Agreement is revoked and all authority granted to the Township by virtue of the Planning Enabling Act, Public Act 33 of 2008 (MCL 123.39801 et seq.) shall be vested in the Bridgewater Township Planning Commission.

Section 5. REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances of Bridgewater Township inconsistent herewith, including without limitation Ordinance 62, are hereby repealed so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication following its publication.
