

Ordinance No. 7 (A)
Township of Bridgewater
Snowmobile Ordinance

An ordinance to regulate and limit the use and operation of snowmobiles in specified areas of Bridgewater Township during certain specified periods of time.

THE TOWNSHIP OF BRIDGEWATER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Definition. "Person" and "Snowmobile" shall have the same meaning as defined in Act 74 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1968 as subsequently amended which is a part of the Michigan Vehicle Code (Michigan Statutes Annotated 9.3200(1) et seq. - Compiled Laws 1948 Section 257.1501)

Section 2. Application. This ordinance shall apply only to Section 1, of Bridgewater Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan.

Section 3. Limitation of Use. No person shall operate a snowmobile in said Section 1, from 11:00 p.m., to 7:00 a.m., except during an emergency, for law enforcement purposes, or when authorized by a permit issued by the Township Board for special events.

Section 4. Violations and Penalties. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereby be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred and 00/100 (\$100.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution thereof or by imprisonment in the Washtenaw County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days or both.

Section 5. Effective Date. A true copy of this ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days after the date hereof in the Saline Reporter a newspaper having circulation in said township and such ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after such publication.
